Our **PAL volunteers** are part of the Auburn Police Department's **Volunteers in Police Service** program (VIPS). Confidentiality and trustworthiness are imperative. **All potential volunteers are subject to a background investigation prior to acceptance.**

Why PAL? The inner-city area of Auburn is the hub for police calls for service. In fact, four years of crime data showed us that 23% of all crimes committed by youth offenders in Auburn took place within an area of <u>less than half a square mile</u>. Additionally, 25% of all police calls for service and 28% of all youth victims were victimized in this same small area.

In an effort to transform these statistics and provide positive experiences for at-risk youth in our community, the Auburn Police Department announced the foundation of the **Auburn Police Activities League**. Auburn's City Council turned over a vacant building at 24 Chestnut Street - along with 7+ acres of green space, basketball courts and playgrounds - for use by Auburn PAL.

The **PAL Center** provides activities for kids after school and during the summer months. This includes mentoring; homework help; art, cooking, gardening and other activities; lots of athletics; healthy snacks and meals; and best of all: **positive interaction with police officers and community volunteers**.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR POTENTIAL PAL VOLUNTEERS...

Volunteers must be able to pass a police department background check and provide character references. Applicants must complete the application/background questionnaire and submit it to the Volunteer Coordinator. Background investigations will be conducted on each applicant. The Volunteer Coordinator and/or the PAL Coordinator *may* interview applicants to ensure that the applicant's interests and skills align with the needs of the organization.

All organizations have guidelines they follow to provide for order and management. A volunteer's work for the Auburn PAL Center entails certain responsibilities:

- Volunteers will conduct themselves in a manner that brings respect to Auburn PAL. Volunteers will perform their duties in an impartial manner consistent with Auburn PAL's policies, rules and regulations.
- Volunteers shall abide by and enforce all PAL rules and regulations.
- ➤ Volunteers shall treat all information that they receive as confidential.
- Volunteers shall not use their association with Auburn PAL or the Auburn Police Department to seek favors for themselves or others.
- ➤ Volunteers who observe apparent misconduct by employees or volunteers shall report that misconduct to their immediate supervisor. Grave infractions shall be brought to the direct attention of the Chief of Police.

Volunteers are subject to dismissal for failure to follow the guidelines for behavior/Rules and Regulations set forth by Auburn PAL. Volunteers are subject to removal from the program at the discretion of the Chief of Police, the Volunteer Coordinator and/or the PAL Coordinator.

Reasons for removal include, but are not limited to, the following:

- o ANY kind of inappropriate behavior toward PAL members
- Committing a felony or misdemeanor
- o Reporting for service in an intoxicated state or possession of intoxicants at PAL
- o Improperly releasing confidential information
- Misconduct (to include profane or abusive language)

PAL RULES (subject to change):

NO CRIMINAL ACTIVITY OF ANY KIND

No weapons or anything resembling a weapon

No smoking in or on the premises

No disrespect to anyone

No foul or vulgar language

No inappropriate touching of any kind

No public displays of affection

No bullying or intimidating other members

No fighting or play fighting

No sagging pants, skimpy clothing, gang-related clothing, or clothing with alcohol, tobacco or

drug products displayed

No vandalism of the PAL Center

No theft of any PAL property

Members and volunteers are responsible for their own stuff (PAL is NOT responsible for any lost or stolen items)

Members and volunteers must sign in and sign out (volunteers must track hours)

Members and volunteers will respect themselves; respect other members, staff and police officers; and respect the facility & neighborhood.
